In 2016 AAAMD in association with UMG reissued the recordings of Marcel Dupré at the Ford Auditorium, St. Thomas, St-Sulpice and St-Ouen in 1957, 1959 and 1965, in a box set of 10 CDs which won the *Diapason d'Or* award. The original tapes were restored by Tom Fine using a revolutionary modern process. See 2016 broadcasts of Pipedreams.

Biographical; numerous photos; good indices and bibliography of selected major books and articles; little information about compositions; discography; specifications of Dupré's house organ and two other organs with which he was associated. Much duplication of Dupré's own "Recollections" amplified and better organized.
